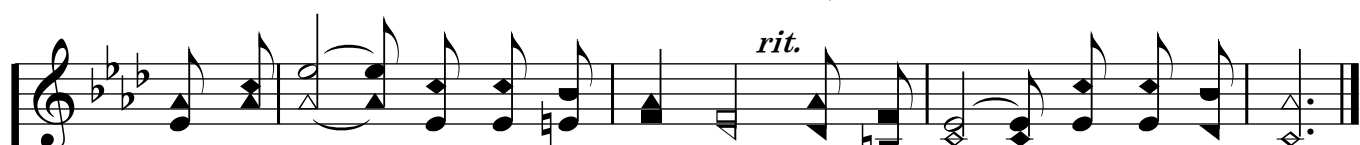
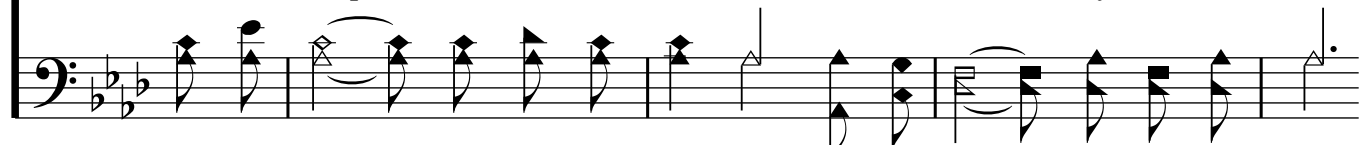
1. God sends springs in - to the val - leys, Flow - ing soft - ly thru the hills;
