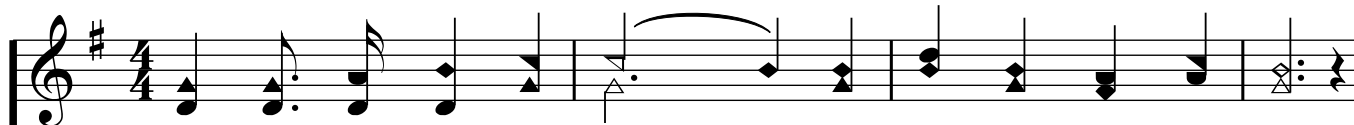

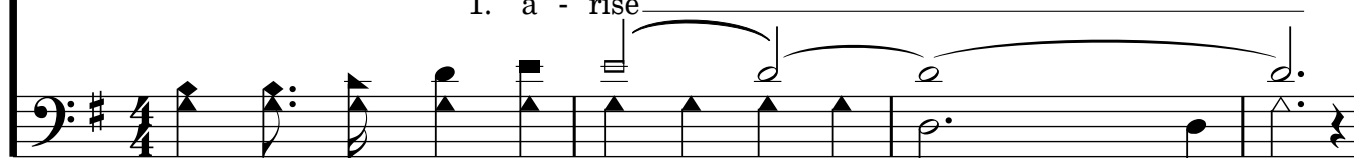

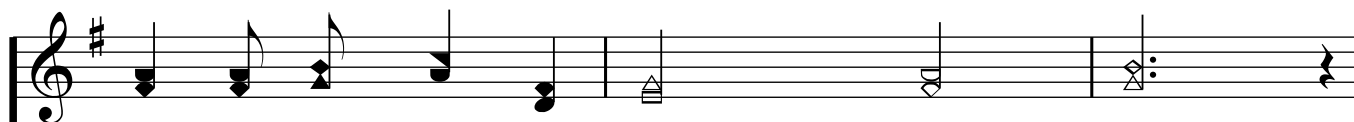
*Be strong in the Lord. . . Put on the whole armor of God,  
that ye may be able to stand. Ephesians 6:10-11*



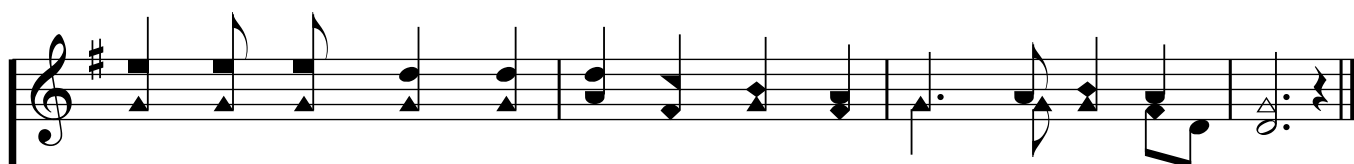
1. Sol - diers of Christ, a - rise And put your ar - mor on;
