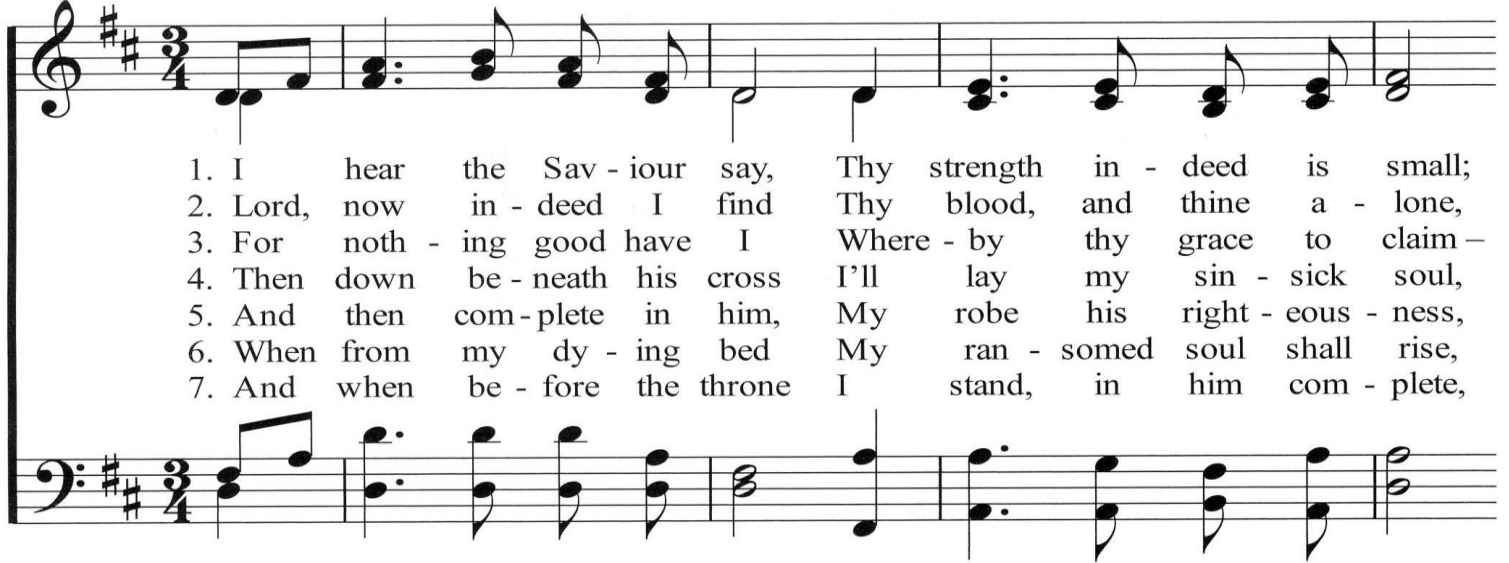


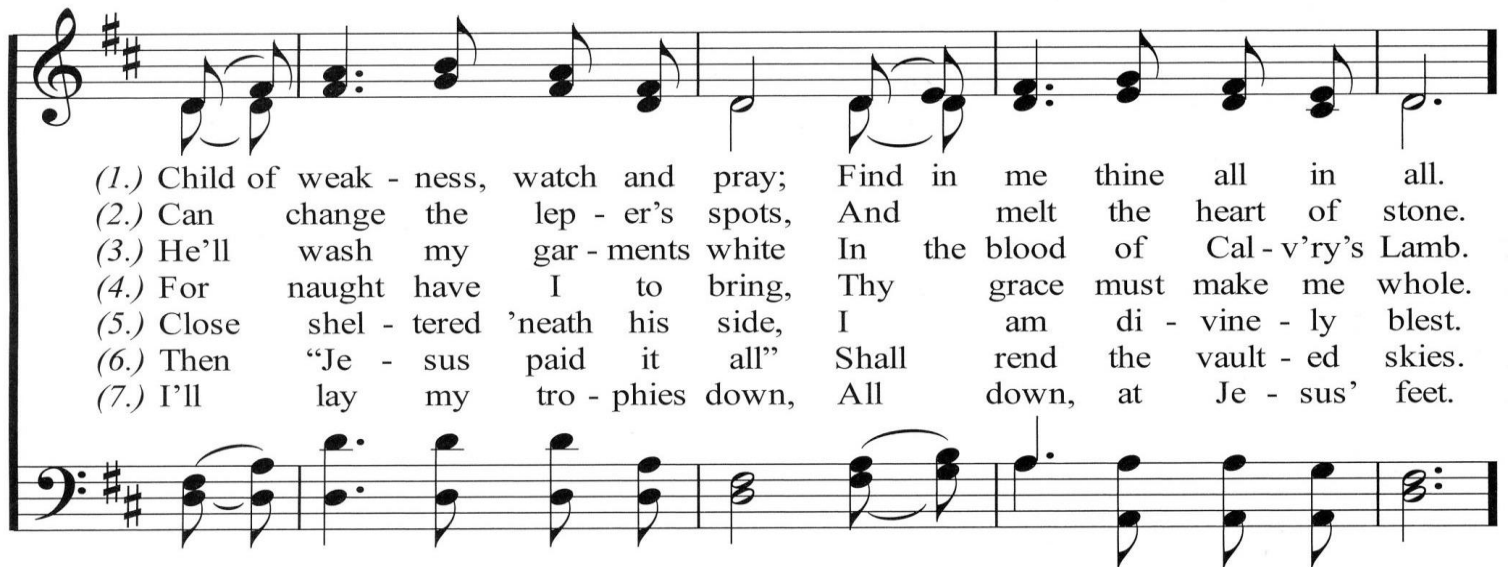
Jesus Paid It All

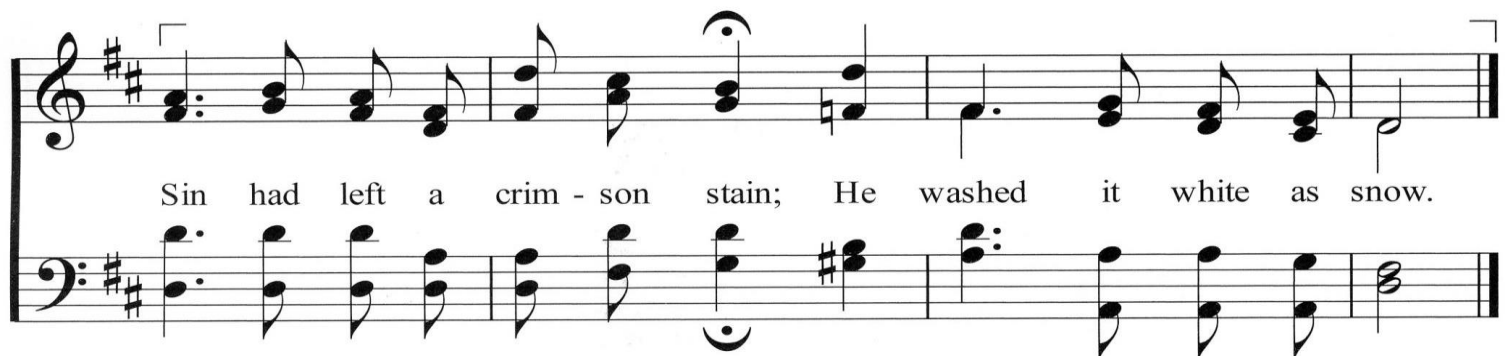
1. I hear the Sav - iour say, Thy strength in - deed is small;
