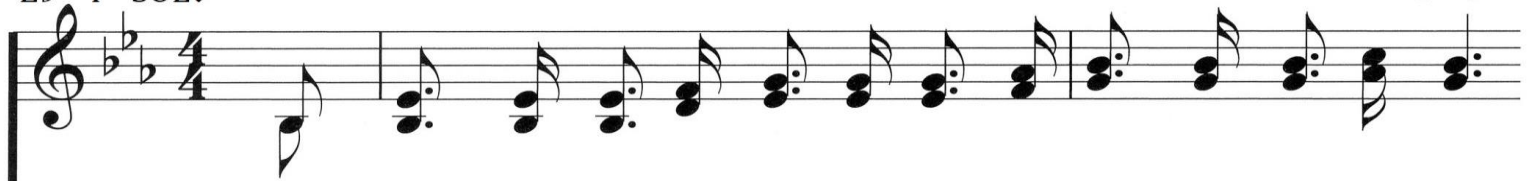

5. Soon I shall see him as he is, The Light that came to me;



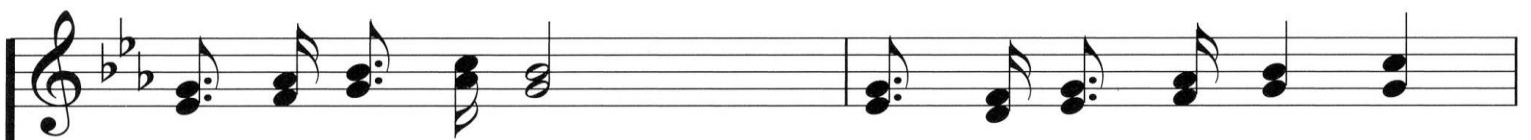
- (1.) And with the sun - light of his love Bid all my dark - ness flee.
